

As I sit down to write this, I cannot believe all that the Lord has done in my life over the past 2 years. First, God put New Life in my life, which has been an experience I will forever cherish and never forget. Then God began to heal me, and teach me about who He is and who I am. He gave me a fresh perspective and taught me forgiveness, so that I could move on from the wounds of my past. He then began to soften my heart and let me see things through a completely different lens. Two years later, I can confidently tell you that God's spirit now lives in me, and the Word of God states specifically, where the Spirit of the Lord is there is Freedom (2 Corinth 3:17).

The best way to describe how I feel today is free and at peace. God has been so faithful and has met every single need for me and my children since I entered New Life on April 1, 2019. Before I made the decision to come into New Life I was in bad shape. I was broken and lost, and had little hope for my future. I did not have anywhere to live, I did not have a car or a job, I was facing a federal prison sentence, and there was a chance my children would be taken from me.

BUT GOD...He changed all of that around!!! My children joined me at New Life for Girls in July 2019 and we transitioned to the Mother and Children's Center in February 2020. We have been inseparable since! I graduated New Life 1 year ago, my federal case was dismissed, I bought a car, and I have been working full time for Wellspan. I recently transitioned out of the Mother & Children's Center into my own 3-bedroom apartment with my 2 daughters (Adrianna, 8yrs and Julianna, 2yrs). Our place is right in the heart of Glen Rock and only 1.2 miles away from The Center. My children are so happy and healthy and I could not have asked for a better transition.

God has been using New Life for a long time to change and transform lives, and he just so happened to use them to get to me, and it worked beautifully. I thank God every day for the people he has placed in my life and for the healing and changes that have taken place in my life as a result. I am not ashamed of who I was but I am happy that I am no longer that person, no longer bound to wrong thinking and toxic relationships. Through this journey, I can confidently say that I truly received a new life and a new identity. Without these last 2 years, I do not know where I would be today.
